Terms and conditions for skip hire

When purchasing a skip or RoRo from Baldwin Skip Hire Ltd you are agreeing to our following Terms and Conditions.

- I confirm that I have fulfilled my duty to apply the waste hierarchy as required by [Regulation 12 of the Waste \(England and Wales\) Regulations 2011](#). And I agree to the hiring and conditions as detailed on our website www.baldwinskyip.co.uk and below.
- Baldwins does **NOT** accept any responsibility for any damaged caused whilst delivering, exchanging or collecting a skip.
- Please ensure that **NO FRIDGES, FREEZERS, BATTERIES, TYRES, GAS BOTTLES, PRESSURISED BOTTLES, MEDICAL SHARPS, PAINT, FOOD WASTE, TVS, FLUORESCENT TUBES, PCS PC MONITORS, LIQUIDS OR OILS** are put in the skips, unless you have been authorised and had in writing to do so.
- **NO ASBESTOS** is to be deposited in the skip(s).
- All Plasterboard must be bagged and tied and laid within the skip. Only 10% Plasterboard allowed in any skip must be double bagged and tied. For any large amounts a skip for **PLASTERBOARD** only must be hired.
- **NO FIRES IN THE SKIPS.**
- **SKIPS MUST NOT BE USED FOR CONCRETE WASH OUT, UNLESS AGREED BY THE OFFICE.**
- Ensure all skips are level filled and not above the fill line on the skip, it MUST be level with the sides and not heaped. Failing to do so, will result in aborted job and wasted journey fee a minimum of £60+VAT for skips and minimum of £80+VAT for RoRo.
- Do not move skips once they have been left by the drivers as this can interfere with the collections or exchanges.
- Non-account customers: where the customer does not have an account with us, the skip MUST be paid before the delivery of the skip(s). If payment is not made the skip will not be delivered.
- Skip hire is for **7 days**, and collection will automatically generate from the 8th day. Additional week hire is **£20.00/week inc. VAT.**
- Account customers, we allow skips to be on site for **1 month**, but we like to see movement on site after a month before a rental of **£15.00+VAT/week** on skips and **£30.00+VAT/week** on RoRo will be applied.
- The time allocated for loading/unloading skip(s) is 15 minutes. If the driver is waiting site for longer than this, a waiting time fee will be charged to the hirer. The contractor reserves the right to charge the customer for all costs incurred because of a late cancellation or change of date of service by way of a wasted journey charge.
- We cannot guarantee specific times for deliveries and collections. We can offer AM (6:30-12pm) or PM (12pm-4:30pm) slots subject to availability but this is never 100% guaranteed, although we will try our best to accommodate.
- When hiring a skip(s) only materials stated when ordering the skip must be disposed of in the skip, if there are any changes of the waste you must let the office know.
- The contents of the skip(s) must not be loaded beyond capacity as stated when ordering (i.e., brick rubble and soil)
- Responsibility cannot be accepted for the equipment or materials deposited in the containers. Materials so deposited are presumed abandoned and to be disposed of by the Contractors.
- All skip(s) must be places off road (i.e., customers driveway or private land) if you are in area where this cannot be possible, we MUST apply for a road permit from the council and price may vary due to area. In which all permits must be coned off with sufficient lighting and NOT moved.
- All property of Baldwin Skip Hire is to be respected and not damaged in any way whilst out on sites, in a case of violation of this condition; a damage fee will be enforced.
- The contractor reserves the right to suspend deliveries and collections without liability for any loss, incurred by the hirer or third party in event of strikes, fire, any other bad weather conditions, driving hours, delays in any type of transport, plant and breakdowns or any other that is out of Baldwin Skip Hires control.
